

## **Blessing Alice with Christ-like Care!**

**John 21:15-17**

Jesus gave us great examples of what caring looks like. He seemed to have time for everyone, but especially those who were vulnerable and labeled “the least of these.” He gave what he had, and I suspect when he didn’t have anything material to give, he gave of himself. Today, as followers of Christ we cannot do less.
